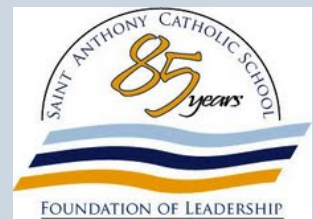
Then and now – the history of our school flashes before our eyes!

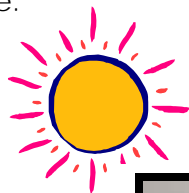

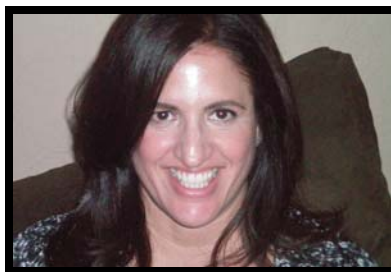
