DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES FOR MIDDLE SCHOOL: Discipline infractions will be tracked in Option C. Parents will be able to view infractions each week. Homeroom teachers will monitor the students in their homeroom. Each quarter, students will start with 0 points, a fresh start.

<u>ACTIVE LEARNER</u>	<u>BEHAVIOR</u>
Responsibility	Uniform, ID badge (3 points), technology (missing or not charged), late to class
Organization	Unprepared for class
Independent work	Cheating (5 points), plagiarism (5 points), not turning in work on time
Collaboration	Disrespect to peers (3 points), off-task during group work/project
Initiative	Not cleaning up after self, off-task during independent work/instructional time
Self-Regulation	Bullying (5 points), fighting (10 points), disrespect to an adult (5 points), classroom disruption (3 points), hallway violation, self-control, improper use of technology (3 points), gum/mints/candy/food in the classroom (3 points), not returning to class during scheduled times

Consequences when a student earns:

- 8 points: Email sent home from homeroom teacher
- 10 points: Lunch detention and email notification
- 15 points: Student, teacher, parent conference and detention; will be suspended from sports and/or school sponsored activities
- 20 points: Student, teacher, principal, parent conference and detention; will be suspended from sports and/or school sponsored activities
- 25 points: In school suspension or Saturday Detention

After 25 points or any major disciplinary infraction, administration can sanction a student suspension or expulsion. A student who has served either a school or home suspension will be placed on DISCIPLINARY PROBATION, and will be ineligible for honors in that grading period. They will be unable to participate in school-sanctioned events for that quarter such as sports, clubs, dances or field trips at the administration's discretion.

CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR: Unless good behavior is maintained it is impossible for teaching and learning to take place. Students are reminded that the code of behavior is not only for their benefit but for the benefit of others as well. All students are expected to respect authority, which includes adherence to school rules, regulations, and procedures.

CONDUCT INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE SCHOOL: Courtesy, consideration, respect, and tolerance are expected of all students in their interaction with other persons, at all times and everywhere. A student is considered a student of St Anthony Catholic School at all times. A student who whether inside or outside the school engages in conduct that is detrimental to the reputation of the school, may be disciplined by school officials. The Principal reserves the right to determine the appropriate disciplinary measure to be taken.

PURPOSE OF PUNISHMENT

Penalties are imposed for habitual violation of the school rules and regulations. They are designed to:

- Develop self-discipline, the understanding of morals and appropriate conduct among students.
- Teach respect for order, law, authority, and the ideals of justice.
- Impress in the minds of the students the importance of rules and regulations.
- Deter the student from future violations.
- Correct and strengthen the character of the student.
- Protect the students

Students are encouraged to do service for our school community in order to receive positive points.
