



## Beginning Sewing at St. Anthony's

Grade 2 and up

Boys and Girls

Tuesdays 3:15-4:15

Students will be making a wardrobe. Each student will be provided with a Kids Can Sew pattern book which has reusable patterns that the student will use all year. Besides learning how to thread a sewing machine, run a bobbin and use the machine to make their projects, students will learn how to build a wardrobe. Students will also be learning fabric selection, cutting, how to use simple patterns and basic garment construction techniques. There are pattern books available for boys, girls and teens.

The tuition covers the cost of the Kids Can Sew booklets and patterns. **Students will be expected to bring their own choice of fabrics for their clothing on Sept. 12.** This will be covered in class and a field trip to JoAnn's will be arranged for those who want help with choosing appropriate materials. **Estimated costs for the fabric and other supplies for the entire year are \$75 depending on the choices of the student.** Students can expect to complete about 5 to 6 garments of their choice from the pattern books; skirts, shirts, shorts, pants, dresses and a few accessories over the year.
