



Saint Anthony Catholic School iPad Agreement

As students are deployed a Saint Anthony iPad, it is important for us to finalize the expectations. All students must use their assigned Saint Anthony Catholic School iPad. Devices will have filters and software to allow students to access their textbooks and allow teachers and staff to monitor student actions on the device. Please review the rules and regulations as a family. Both parent and student need to sign the bottom of this sheet in order to receive the device:

- iPads are required to be in a hardcover case with an attached keyboard at all times.
- If your iPad is damaged, you must report it immediately to your homeroom teacher. The first repair will cost \$50, the second repair will cost \$150.
- If you lose your iPad, you will have to pay the full cost to replace the device.
- Students must adhere to the AUP in the Family Handbook (see attached).
- If your device is taken away for inappropriate use or breaking the Acceptable Use Policy (AUP), you will have to meet with administration to determine appropriate consequences.
- The use of the device is limited to educational purposes under the guidelines set forth in the Saint Anthony Family Handbook, unless teacher approved.
- The device must remain in the possession of the student to whom it is assigned. The borrowing or exchanging of devices between students is prohibited.
- Students are not to remove any DNS/Saint Anthony Catholic School identification labels from the iPad
- Students are not to decorate their iPads with stickers, markings, etc. in any way.
- Students are responsible for bringing the device fully charged to every class every day.
- The administration, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to amend these regulations at any time, and also to impose disciplinary action as it deems appropriate.
